

## **Workplace Learning Connection**

Regional Intermediary serving K-12 Work-based Learning for educators and students in Benton, Cedar, Iowa, Johnson, Jones, Linn and Washington Counties (~37,000 students 6th - 12th grade; 108 buildings)

#### Provide a one-stop contact point

- Develop work-based capacity with employers
- Provide core service programming
- Equal access for all schools and all students


#### Team of 16 staff across 4 campuses

## **How Our Model Works**



#### We live by the concept of 'one point of contact'

- Our schools have one contact on our team and we have one contact at school
  - Our businesses have one contact on our team



## **How Our Model Works**

#### Middle school

- 6th grade speakers
  - School based w/ specific career clusters identified by school
- 7th grade STEAM Institute
  - All students bussed to <u>four regional centers</u> w/ about 4,500 students participating across 9 days; 3 sessions per student
- 8th grade Financial Literacy Fair
  - All students bussed to four regional centers w/ about 4,500 students participating across 17 days

## **How Our Model Works**

#### **High School**

- 2 school specific programs (industry tours, mock interviews, classroom speakers, professional skills workshops)
- 3 job shadows per year per student (10th 12th grade)
- 3 internships per year per student (11th 12th grade)
- Large scale events
  - Construction Apprenticeship Fair (440 students), Build My Future (750 students), STEM It Up (1,400 students), Career Discovery Tours (1,000 students)

## **Outcomes**

• 85%-Positively influenced their selection of a career field

- 93% Increased awareness of local career opportunities
- 73% Positively influenced their decision to live/work in lowa
- 56% Were offered additional employment opportunities by business (vs 29% pre-COVID)
- 62% of job shadow and internship students enroll in concurrent or directly to post-secondary vs 25% across the region





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
