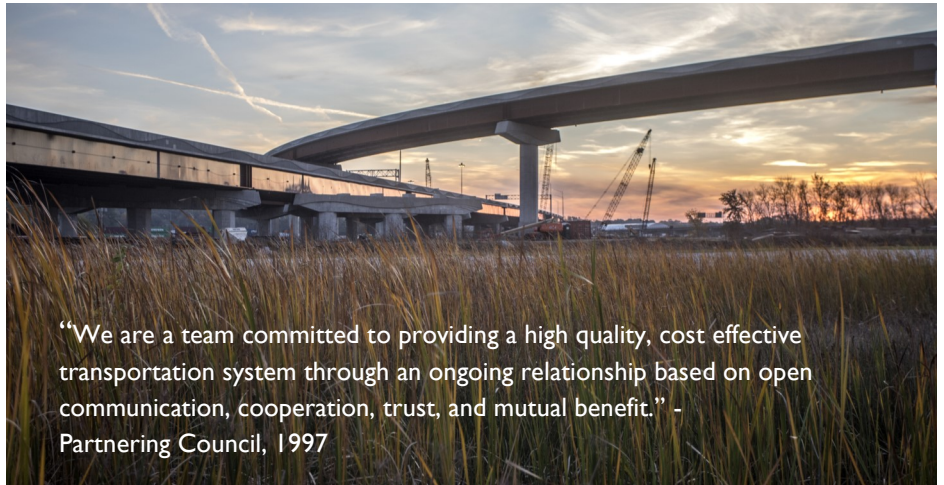
**The Iowa Transportation Conference**
